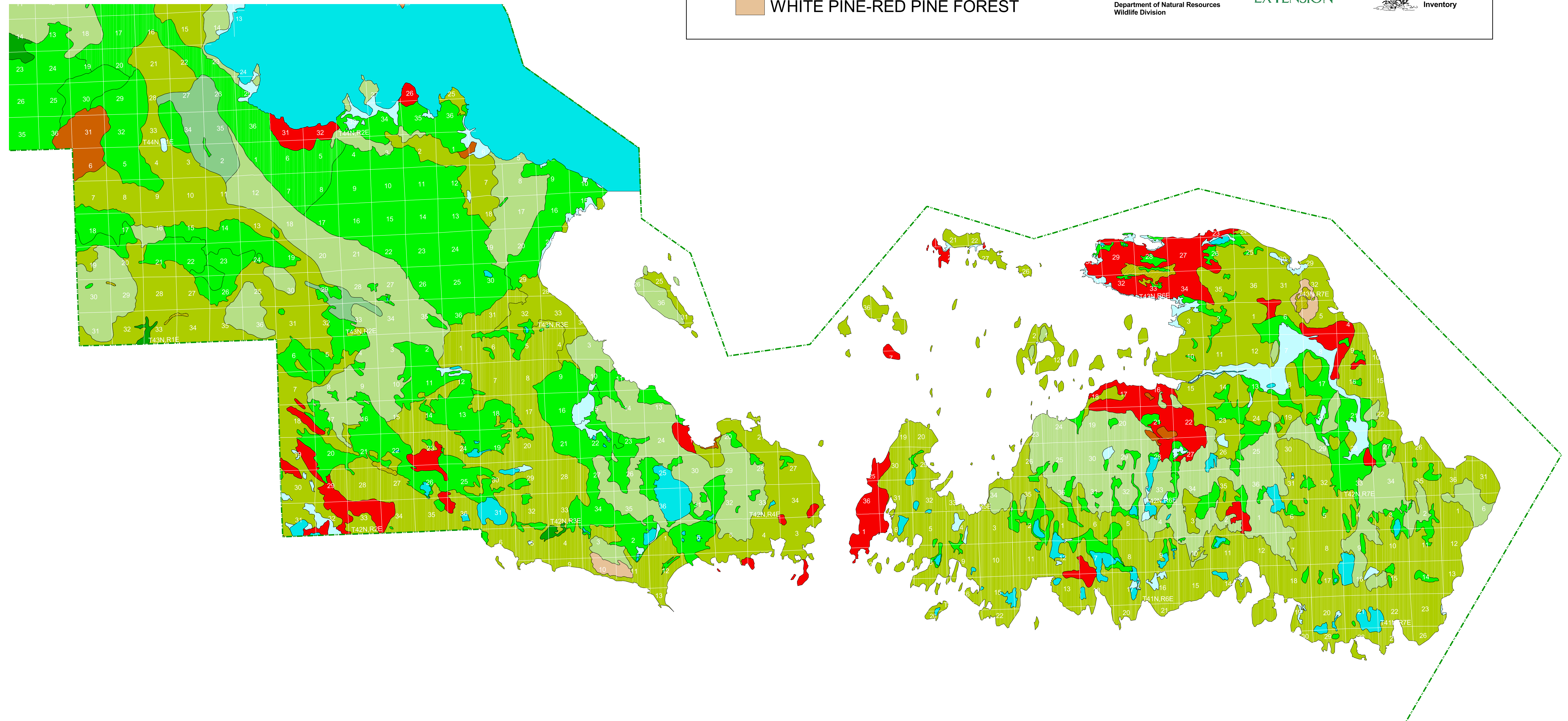


# Vegetation circa 1800 of Chippewa County, Michigan EAST PART

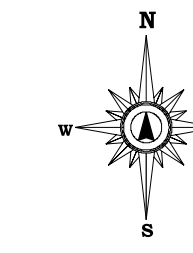
