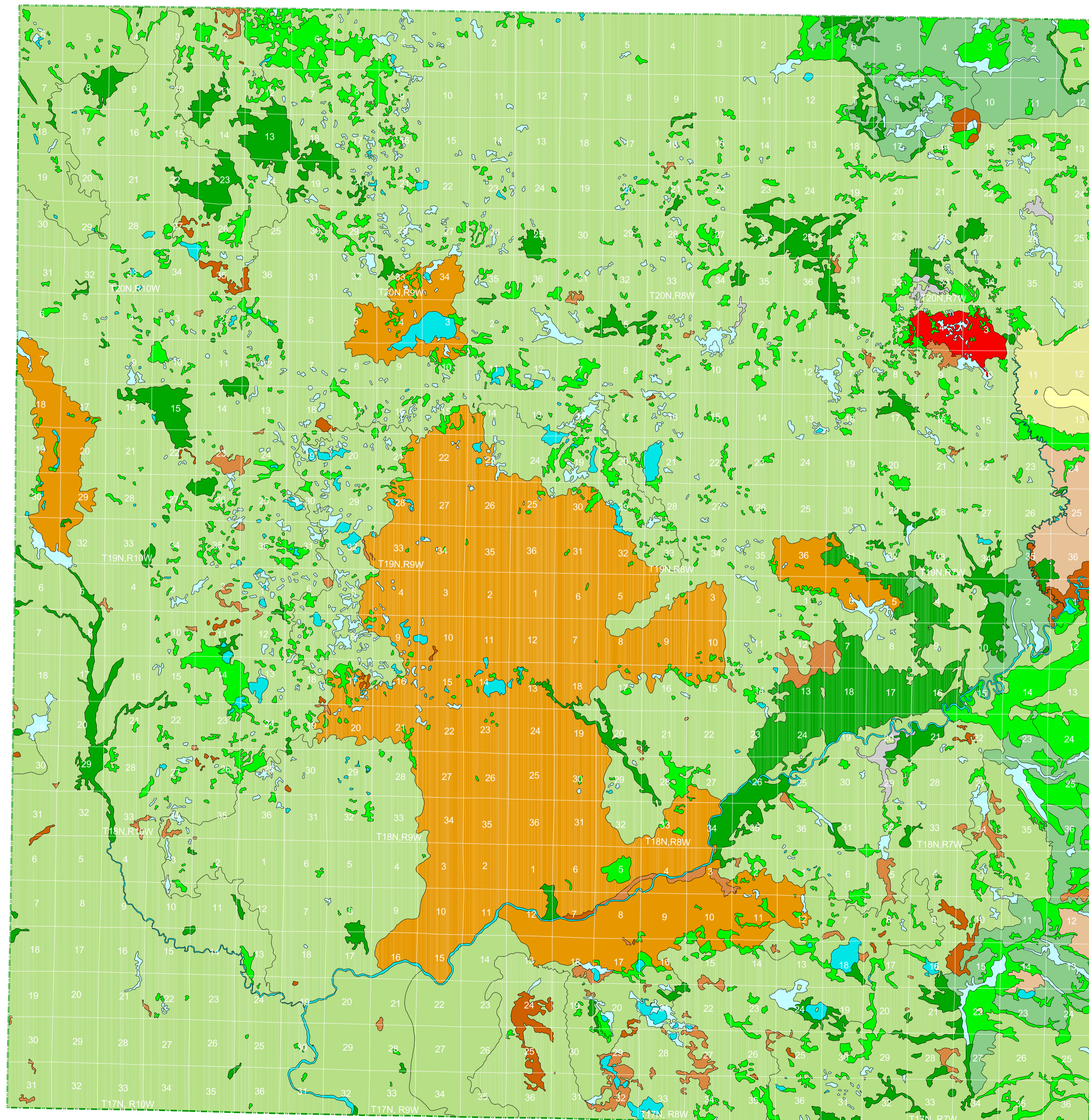


Vegetation circa 1800 of Osceola County, Michigan

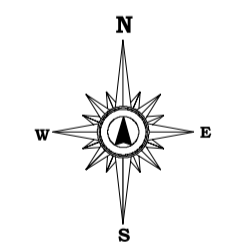
